Christmas aerogrammes overprinted in capitals with **SPECIMEN** in violet, length 78 mm.

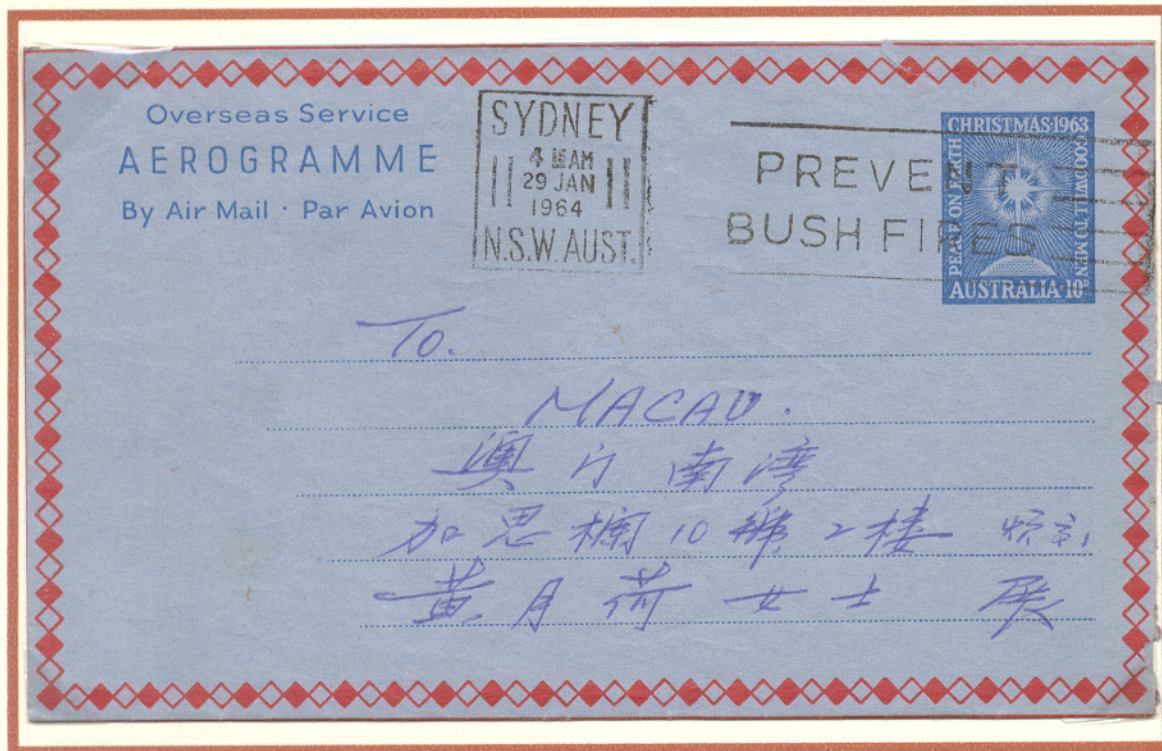

Aerogramme sent from Sydney January 29, 1964 to Macau January 31, 1964.

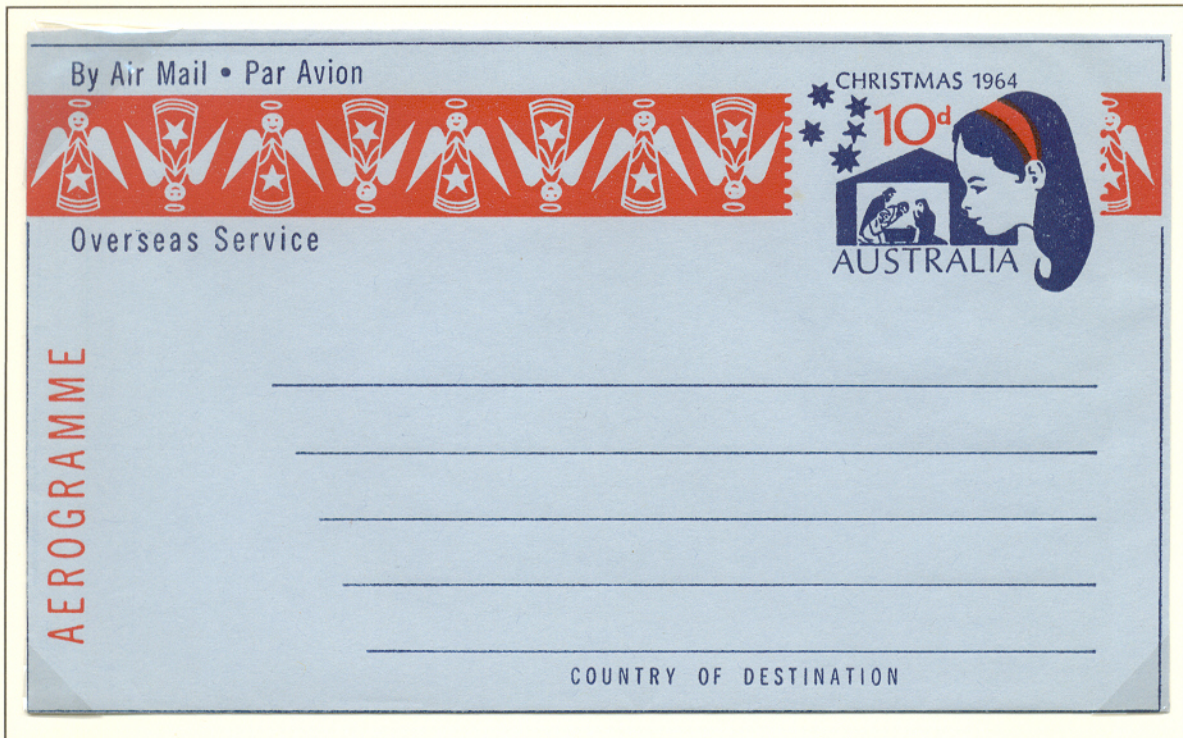

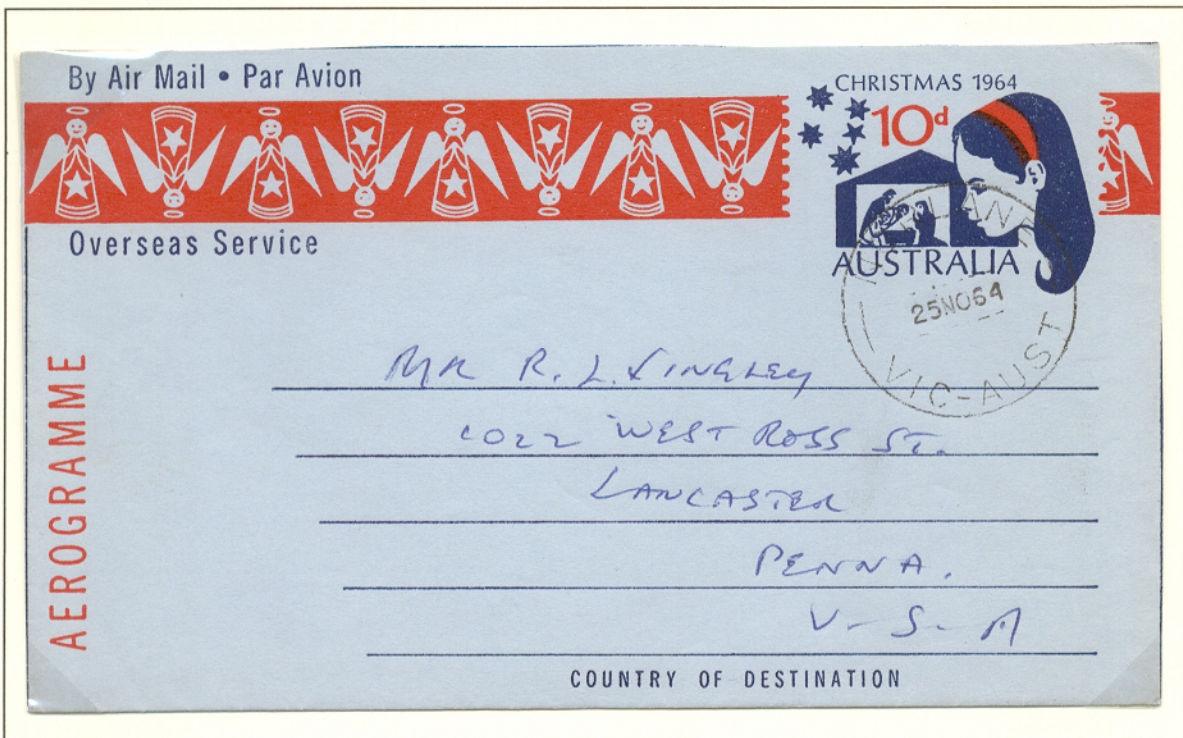

Aerogramme sent on **first day of issue** from Norlane VIC November 25, 1964 to **Lancaster, USA.**



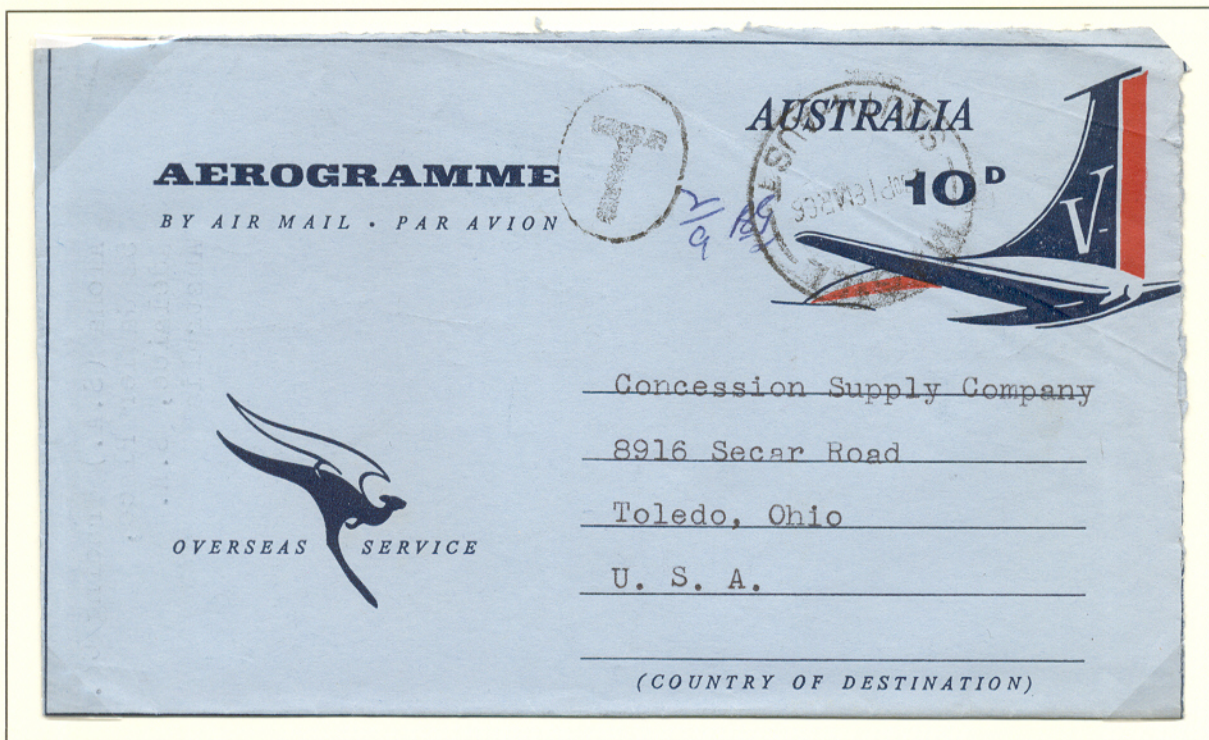
## AEROGRAMMES

Blue and heleon red printing on azure paper.  
First day April 26, 1965.



Aerogramme sent from Melbourne March 9, 1966 to **Göteborg, Sweden.**

After the introduction of Decimal currency, February 14, 1966, the new rate for an Aerogramme was 9 cent. The old 10 penny Aerogramme had a face value of 8 cents so an extra 1 cent stamp had to be affixed to full do the postal rate.



Taxed aerogramme sent March 18, 1966 to **Toledo, Ohio USA.**  
Taxed by the Australian post with an **oval T**. The American post did not cash the deficiency.

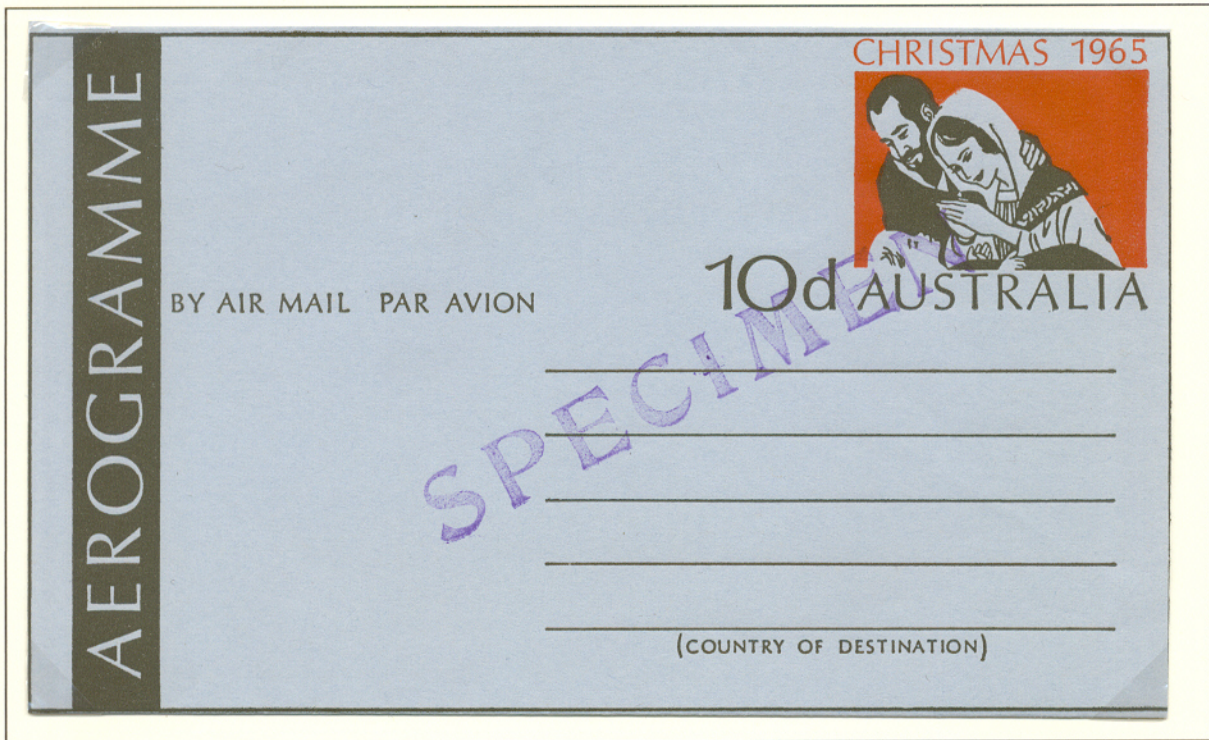
Aerogramme sent from Brisbane Queensland December 10, 1965 to **San Francisco, USA.**

This aerogramme was first sold on 18 August 1965 only at the GPO sales points in each state, but additionally, from 23 August to 2 September, at a temporary post office in the basement of Selbourne Chambers, 174 Philip Street, Sydney, where the Conference was held. **It was available for about two weeks.**

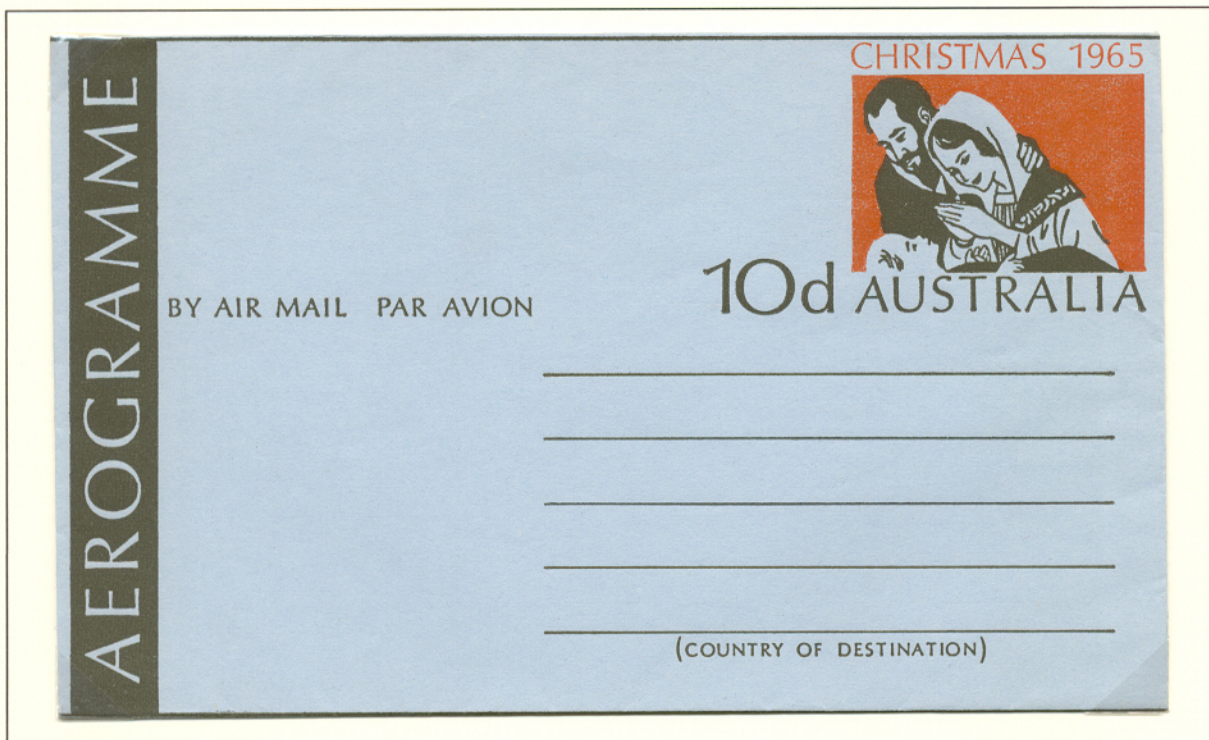

Aerogramme overprinted in capitals with **SPECIMEN** in violet, length 78 mm.

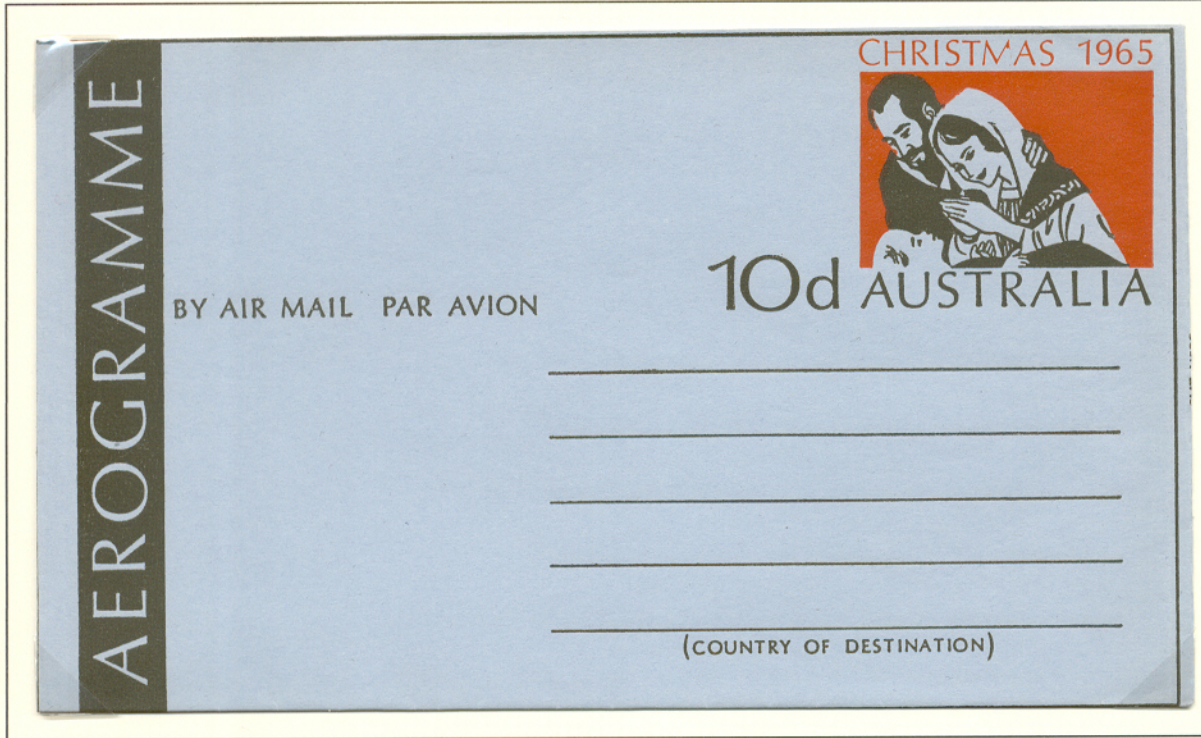

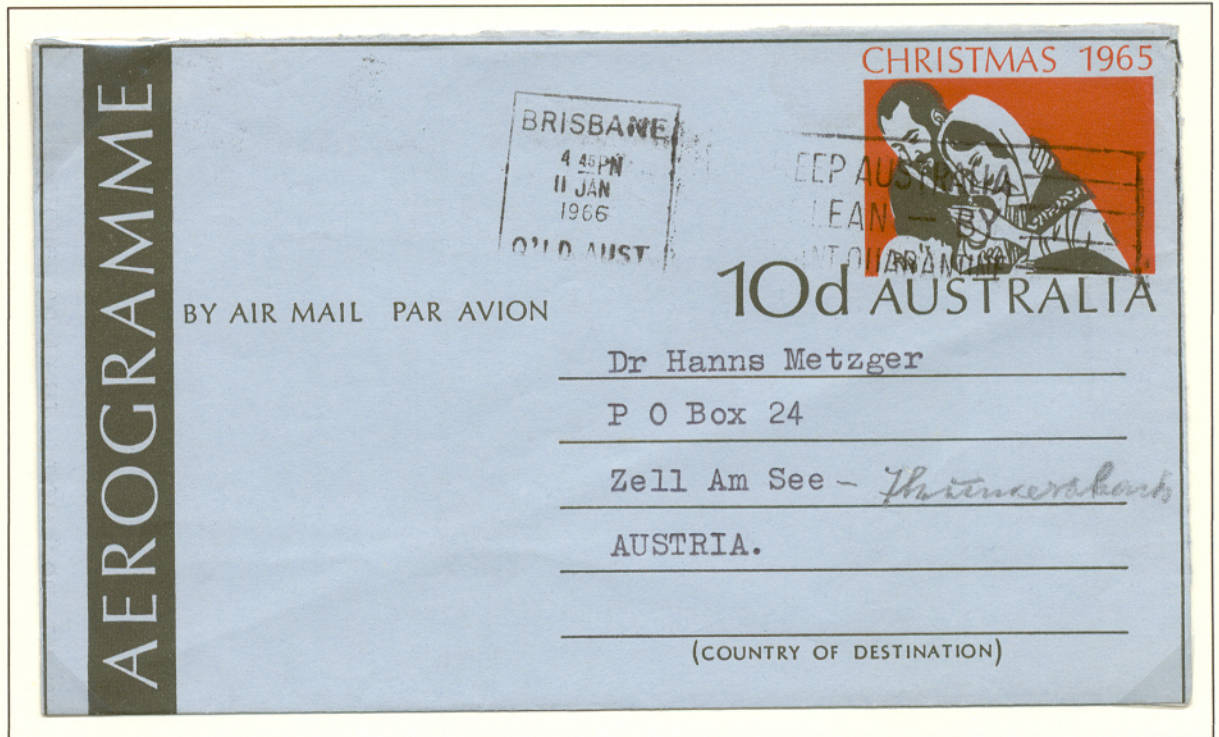

Underpaid aerogramme sent from Campsie, NSW March 6, 1966 to **Jelenia Góra, Poland**.  
 Double deficiency paid in Poland with two postage due stamps 20 Groszy and 60 Groszy = 80 Groszy.
